- cou-de-pied, sur le = at the neck of the foot
- croisé, croisée = crossed
- écarté = wide apart, step aside, swerving
- 12. effacé, effacée = shaded
- 13. Ouvert, ouverte = open
- 14. Détourné = turned aside
- 15. Pas de deux = a dance for two
- penché, penchée = leaning, inclining
